Literacy

Mathematics

- This week we will focus on the concept of five and a bit. We will use Numicon to make 6, 7, 8, 9- looking at the pattern of each number being made of 5 and a bit more.
- We will play number games in pairs.
- Maths of the day: We will take part in a number bootcamp. Children will find number dot cards around the playground once found they will be asked to subitize the amount of dots and do an action that many times. E.g. 5 hops, 7 jumps etc.
