- Year group collective worship.

Literacy



- This week we will explore a range of non-fiction minibeast books.
- Phonics- We will learn to new 'special friends'. We will be reading and writing simple sentences using the sounds we have learnt in our phonics groups.
- We will make our own 'What am I?' minibeast books by writing clues.
- We will label the bug houses we design using words/captions.
- I can see 'minibeast' sentences.

Mathematics

- We will be thinking about number bonds to 5, focusing on subtraction facts, using hidden minibeasts.
- We will make sets of 7, 8 and 9.
- We will play a Jack and the beanstalk counting game.
- We will complete minibeast addition calculations using the 10's frame.
- Capacity using containers and dry pasta (full and empty)
- Maths of the day: We will explore directional language. We will work in pairs, taking it in turns to be a robot. We will direct our robots using instructions such as forward 1, backwards 2 etc.
