

RE/RSE/PSHE



- For our Handmade with Love RSE topic, we will focus on the story of creation. We will take part in a range of activities which will help us to understand that we were created by God out of love and for love.

Literacy



- This week our text is 'Meg and Mog'.
- In our phonics sessions this week we will learn to read and write the letters w, y, x and z. We will practice blending simple CVC words with Fred.
- We will make a rhyming potion. We will become witches and make a potion using words that rhyme. Can we write our potion?
- We will use magnetic letters to make CVC words on witches brooms.

Mathematics

- We will sing a range of number rhymes and songs.
- We will be comparing amounts using the language of more and fewer.
- We will work in pairs to take a handful of counters and place them on a hand. Who has more and who has fewer?
- Adding the correct amount of legs to the numbered spiders.
- Maths of the day: We will have a number of cones (witches hats) placed in the outdoor area. The children will be put in 2 teams. They will compete to see how many cones they can collect in 30 secs. Which team has more? Which team has fewer?

- We will introduce the children to our new topic of seasons and celebrations. We will discuss Halloween and how the children celebrate it.
- We will discuss bonfire night and learn about firework safety.
