### RE

### Maths



Number formation and sequencing of numbers to 20.

We will continue to use the part/part whole model and the bar model to help us write addition number sentences, using numbers to 10.

### Science



This week we will go to Bruntwood park to investigate the types of materials we find in and around the park - in particular the playground.

### History



We will recap on all the information Mrs Noar gave us about her childhood.

Using the loan box from the Portland Basin Museum the children will have hands on experience of objects from the 1950's and 1960's

### PE
