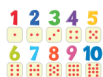


RE/RSE/PSHE

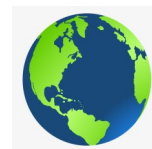
- This week we will listen to the story of 'The Happiest Day'. We will think about what this story means for us.
- Circles– We will be discussing good and bad feelings.

Literacy

- Phonics– this week we will learn new special friends in our phonics groups. We will read our new reading books and practise writing words and sentences.
- Our text this week is 'Peepo by Janet and Alan Ahlberg.
- We will write sentences to show what we can see on a picture from the book 'Peepo'.
- We will write words/captions to label what is happening in a picture.

Mathematics

- We will be focusing on addition through a range of activities: we will use double sided counters to add 2 numbers to 5, We will use 2 coloured cubes to complete addition calculations in pairs. We will also practise writing number sentences.
- We will be making patterns of 5 using paint and cotton buds. How many different ways can we show 5?
- Maths of the Day: We will use a large number line outside to add 1 more by jumping along the number line.

- We will be looking at a range of household items from the past. We will explore the objects and discuss what we think they were used for. We will be talking about the similarities and differences in the objects from the past and objects we use in our homes now.
