<u>RE</u>  <u>Creation and Covenant</u> We will begin to learn the story of Noah, think about God's special promise to all living creatures and the symbol of the rainbow.	<u>Maths</u>  We will look at place value of numbers within 50. We will be comparing numbers and counting how many tens and ones belong to each 2-digit number. We will be forming and spelling numbers 1-20.
<u>English</u>  This week we will read 'Dear Teacher' by Amy Husband. We will be asking questions as we read the text. We will be predicting where the main character might go next, using conjunctions in sentences and writing a short letter.	<u>Art/DT</u>  We will look at the work of Alma Thomas and find out a little about her life.
<u>Science</u>  This week we will make comparisons between two plants and trees, identifying similarities and differences.	<u>Geography</u>  We will go outside to observe and sketch the weather. We will use weather vocabulary to describe what we saw. We will make predictions.
<u>Computing</u>  We will reinforce the importance of internet safety. We will practise how to log on and off Purple Mash. And we will explore how to access our 'to do' list. We will begin to learn about simple coding.	<u>PHSE/RSE</u>  We will begin to develop an understanding of 'British Values' and be able to understand why they are important.
