RE



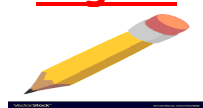

Science



This week we will be looking at different types of habitats and thinking about different types of animals that live in each one..

History

Computing



This week we will add sounds to a tune to improve it. We will think about how music can be used to express feelings and create tunes which depict feelings.
