

RE/RSE/PSHE



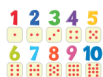
- We will introduce the children to our new topic 'Sorrow and Joy'. We will think about what the word joy means. When do we feel joy? We will sing, clap and jump for joy.

Literacy



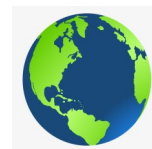
- Our text for this week is 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' by Eric Carle.
- Phonics– this week we will learn new special friends in our phonics groups. We will read our new reading books and practise writing words and sentences.
- We will write a shopping list for the Hungry Caterpillar.
- We will make a book to show the life cycle of a butterfly.

Mathematics



- We will focus on subitising to 6. We will roll 10 marbles down a tube, on to the table and then talk about what we can see. Can anyone spot any groups of 6?
- We will use egg boxes to find collections of 6 objects. We will look at partners to 6.
- We will play an addition game. The children will drop 6 double sided counters. How many red? How many yellow? How many altogether? Can you write the calculations.
- 3 colour repeating pattern caterpillars.
- Make a symmetrical butterfly.

Understanding the World



- We will be learning all about the lifecycle of a butterfly. We will make our own lifecycle books.
- We will learn facts about caterpillars and butterflies.
- To celebrate Earth day we will spend time in Forest school looking for all of the wonderful things God created. Can we find any signs of growth and life?
