Year 2 - Week Beginning 22.9.2025



We will begin the week with a Harvest festival and link this to our learning about 'stewardship' and caring for God's world. We will learn that God knows everything about us and think about psalms in the Bible. We will know that psalms are like poems or songs written in the Bible.



This week we will at place value using number lines. We will compare 0-10 and 0-100 number lines, find missing numbers and estimate where given numbers should be.
