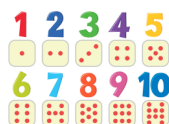


RE/RSE/PSHE

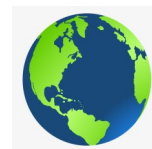
- This week our RSE theme is Loving God, Loving others– we will talk about how we are all part of different communities.

Literacy
