

Year 2 - Week Beginning 25.11.2024

RE



This week we will discuss the meaning of Advent and we will recognise some signs and symbols of Advent. The children will write their own Advent promise. We will learn about the prophet Isaiah and the message he gave from God about Jesus.

Maths



This week we will learn how to find ten more and ten less than a 2-digit number. We will also be solving problems involving adding and subtracting tens.

English



This week we will continue to read 'The King who banned the Dark' by Emily Howorth- Booth. We will imagine what it might be like to live without darkness and we will write a diary entry.

Shared Reading



We will continue to read 'How to hide a lion' by Helen Stephens. We will discuss how different characters feel when the lion runs away.

Science



This week we will discuss 'drink swapping' and discussing alternative healthy ideas for drinks. We will also be looking at the effect of sugar on enamel and linking this to keeping our teeth clean and healthy.

PHSE/RSE



Basic first aid.

We will know what basic first aid is and discuss times when we have needed it. We will understand the importance of asking an adult for help.

History



This week we will find out about The Memorial Gates' in Hyde Park which remember people who fought in WW1 and 2 from around the British Empire who often get overlooked.

PE



We will continue to practise team games and learn strategies to earn points. We will play and share our games with others. In gymnastics we will begin to link travelling actions and balances using apparatus.
