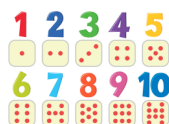


RE/RSE/PSHE

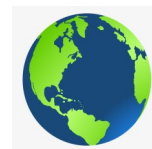
- This week we will think about the Church. Have we ever been to church? What did we do there? What do you see at a church? We will talk about some of the features/items that we see in church.
