



Year 1—Autumn Term 1A



R.E. - Creation and Covenant

- Hear the story of Creation in Genesis. Recognise that the story of creation is an ancient, prayerful, poetic, reflection of God's World.
- Recognise that the church teaches that all that is comes from God, Our Father, who made heaven and earth. Recognise that though people cannot see God, they can experience His presence in the beauty and order of creation.
- Recognise that prayer is a way of drawing closer to God.
- Hear The Nicene Creed and know that as a community, the church prays the creed to God to worship Him.
- Know that Pope Francis wrote a letter called "Laudato Si", about the gift of Creation and the importance of taking care of our world as it is everyone's home.
- Recognise that God gave human beings the responsibility for taking care of the world and in doing this, we show love for God and each other. Discuss how we can care for God's world.

Maths



- Counting and sorting numbers to 10
- Counting forwards and backwards and saying the number 1 before and after.
- Comparing numbers to 10 and introducing < and >
- Ordering numbers and ordinal numbers
- Introducing part and whole model
- Number bonds to 10
- Simple addition—adding together, adding more and adding using number bonds.
- Number formation.

PSHE

We will focus on the children's feelings starting a new school year and the fears/anxiety they may have.

Re-introduce the Colour Monster and our checking in system.

English



- Recap on the letter sounds they learnt in reception and continue to develop their knowledge.
- Formation of lower case letters
- Listen to traditional stories and be able to discuss and describe characters, settings problems and solutions in each story.
- Write in sentences using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
- Using the sounds they know in their reading.
- Ask and answers questions about a book they have read or has been read to them.
